

## F.C.C. TSR Honda France Announces Continued Participation in the 2025 FIM Endurance World Championship

F.C.C. TSR Honda France, operated by TSR / TECHNICAL SPORTS RACING, will continue to compete in the FIM Endurance World Championship(FIM EWC) for the 2025 season.

The team began full competition in 2016 and has accumulated numerous victories around the world, including three wins in Le Mans, France, one win in Bol d'Or, two wins in Oschersleben, Germany, and one win at the Estoril circuit in Portugal. The team has also been crowned champion twice, in the 2017-18 and 2022 seasons.

Unfortunately, the 2024 season was a difficult one and we were unable to achieve our goals, but for the 2025 season we have restructured our team structure and will continue to challenge for a third title.
