F.C.C. TSR Honda France Launched for 2024. 3 riders all together for the Okayama Winter Test. Basic specifications for the 2024 season are decided!

F.C.C. TSR Honda France held its annual winter test. Two cars were brought to the Okayama International Circuit: the #1 F.C.C. TSR Honda France Trico-coloured 2023-spec car and the #5 new CBR, freshly assembled and with its carbon cowl still in place. The main focus of the project was to conduct various tests on each part of the car to determine the best directional specification.

Based on the specifications decided on this time, the team will concentrate on preparing for 24 HEURES MOTOS on 20-21 April 2024, when the season opener.
